



A column of approx 1,000 enemy vehicles, extending 18 kms N from MONTELIMAR, was stopped by our artillery fire and the vehicles captured by our infantry. The two regiments took close to 900 PWs in the foothills during the periods

b. Infantry:

(1) 7th Inf: Attacking on the left of the division zone, the 7th Inf assaulted N from MONTELIMAR along Hwy 7 and the high ground to the immediate E of the highway. There was no organized resistance but the 2nd Bn ran into considerable sniper fire while clearing the hills, and received flakwagon, mortar and S/A fire from a column of enemy vehicles which was halted along the road. The 2nd Bn relieved 3rd Bn 143rd Inf on high ground Vic N-935613 at 1300B. At the same time the 3rd Bn was moving N in the N-9358 grids with the 1st Bn following to the right rear at N-965610. The 2nd Bn observed for arty fire on the enemy convoy, then directed additional arty fire on halted column and vehicle drivers. It also directed fire or a train pulling a RR gun, stopping the train and wrecking three or four boxcars. At 1600B the 2nd Bn occupied the West slope of a ridge, extending from N-939630 to N-932620. The 3rd Bn was in position on a hill directly S of that, from N-937609 to N-934595. The 1st Bn put a Plat on a hill Vic N-960625 to hold the high ground until relieved by a Bn of the 30th Inf. 

Morning 29 August: 143d Inf Regt: 1st Bn at 9774, 2nd Bn at 9561, 3d Bn at 935602. 141st Inf: 1st Bn 985595, 2nd Bn 975590, 3d Bn 992602. 142nd Inf: 1st Bn manned roadblocks, 2nd Bn at 990775, 3d Bn at 997787. 142nd and 143d Inf Regts repulsed a Bn size enemy counterattack. 141st Inf occupied CLEARY and SCUZETE. The 7th Inf attacked WEST on the MORTH side of the EAST-WEST road leading into the City, and contacted the 36th Inf Div to the NORTH. The 30th Inf moved in conjunction with the 7th Inf and cleared out opposition SOUTH of the road. A great deal of materiel and a proximately 1000 FW's were taken during the attack.

(1) 7th Inf: The Regt attacked generally WEST and NORTHWEST. entering MONTELIMAR shortly before noon 29 Aug, contacted elements of the 36th Inf Div and occupied the important hill mass vicinity 938602. At 1445B the 1st Bn moved through to lead the assault and an hour later reached NO19565, advancing through enemy arty fire. Enemy resistance in Batie continued and L Co flanked the town from the right. Several RV's were taken at the town and the rest withdrew on bicycles. At 1910B the 1st Bn reached the 995 EASTING, with K Co at 005, I Co 800 to 1000 yds to the rear and L Co at the left rear vic N-15550. - Information of adjacent and supporting units:
 a. 45th Inf Div: At the start of the period the 45th Div had established defensive positions along the general line 6977 -5056 - 4461 - 4455. Maintained roadblocks within their sector, one being at 4461, another at 438553. Patrol was sent from ROGNES to LAMBESE and contacted elements of the 3d Div in the latter town. 1st Bn 157th Inf moving on APT and at last report were in vicinity 465795 with no opposition. 179th Inf (-1 Bn) captured GRENABLE with the other Bn in vicinity of the Div CP at ASPREMONT. 130th Inf (-1 Bn) advanced toward LE ROCHETTE with the other Bn advancing in the direction of LE PUY SANIERES.

 b. CCI - 1st FR Armd Div: CP at GEMENOS (671161). Continued to advance toward MARSEILLE, 1 Bn advancing cross country WEST to 523199, 1 unit on the road vicinity 245163, 1 unit at 630078 advancing to the WEST to 535075, 1 unit guarding the reservoi at 422335, 1 unit advancing to 407397, and 1 unit guarding the town

- Weather and Visibility: Fair and warm. Visibility excellent.
- Our Operations for the Period: General: Our troops pushed on to SALON and LAMBESC to the NORTHWEST without meeting resistance, then patrolled beyond to PONT ROYAL and LA COURRONNE. Rcn Tr sent patrols around both sides of ETANG DE BERRE to MARTIQUE (T2026) and found the area cleared of enemy. 15th Inf protected the Division's left flank with roadblocks NORTH of MARSEILLE. 1st En 7th Inf received fire from enemy tks NORTHWEST of LAMBESC. Contact maintained with 45th Inf Div on the right and French 3 DIA on the left.

nf: A coremained in efensive post tion 15th Inf: in the town of GARDANNE (T5333), B Co moved the afternoon of 22 Aug to vicinity T420350 and C Co established a roadblock vicinity T465295. A road junction there was held during the night, although fire was received from enemy who were fighting French units 500 to 1000 yards SOUTH of the junction. Morning of 23 Aug A Co and Bn Hq moved from GARDANNE to a reserve position near B Co. The 2nd Bn advanced to the following positions: E Co (with Bn AT Platoon, section of MG's and 2 light ths) vicinity T225402, F Co (in reserve with section of HMG's and section of mortars) vicinity T300428 and G Co (with Regtl AT plat, section of HMG's and section of mortars) vicinity T295470. Four TD's and 4 Tks were kept in reserve vicinity T420300 and the Bn CP was at LA FARE (T3042). At 230910B the Bn was ordered to move forward to the final-phase-line. K Co moved to vicinity T455299, with one platoon going to T430268. I co moved to vicinity of GIGNAC (T345255) and was in position at 222000B. L. Enemy arty fire was very light, mostly harassing fire in towns.
