- 0514- White: Armored and motor movement 2000 yards from our front line position.

 Movement seems to be from our L Co to the north. This movement has been going on since 0400 hours.
- 0545- Lt Ramirez to G-3: Gives them a summary of the reports for the last hour.
- 0556-Blue: At 0513 hours Co K reported hearing a good many tanks and trucks at a 20 degree azimuth, approximately 800 yards, and believe them to be moving northeast. Co L at 0545 hours reported patrol that investigated the trip wires cannot find any evidence of damage. The woods in which the booby traps were set, was so dark that you couldn't see a thing.
- 0600- Decoy Blue: Negative report.
- 0605- G-2 to Lt Ramirez: What is going on in your front? (Lt Ramirez) Gives them a summary of the night's reports.
- O610- White: On this movement we have been reporting I have checked with the OPs but I can't get them to agree on the direction of the movement. Just as soon as we get observation I will give you's full report.

0615- Red: Negative report.

- 0630: Lt Ramirez to G-3: Gives them a summary of the reports received during the last hour.
- 0740- Red 5 to S-3: Can you give me the location of your next place? (S-3) Tentatively 902393.
- 0815- S-3 to Blue 3: Did you speak to anyone over at Decoy Blue in regard to the mine field that he laid there? (Blue 3) Yes.
- 0817- S-3 to Decoy Blue: Are you acquainted with the mine field that our Blue Bn left there? (Decoy Blue) No, I am not. (S-3) I will see that they get over and give you the dope on it.
- 0820- S-3 to Blue 3: Have Lt Roehrig get over to Decoy Blue right awam and explain about the mine field to them. (Blue 3) I talked to Capt Scottsmith over there and gave him the coordinates of it. The minefield was laid by AT Co, not by us.
- 0840- S-3 to Engr Off: The 3rd Bn 18th is attached to us. We want you to lay a mine-field for them todnight. (Engr Off) Ok.
- O843- Lt Roehrig to S-2: In regard to the mines, none of the mine fields belong to us. I know about one and reported it to Regiment. Whoever lays the minefield is supposed to report it. I reported the one in front of K Co and they reported it to the people who relieved them. But I did not know that they had laid 3 road blocks until now.
- 0855- Freeport OP: At 0730 hours at 900486 two enemy trucks with trailers, one with AA gun on it going east to Merzbruck; at 0710 hours one horse drawn cart with 3 enemy infantry going east on military highway at 925471; at 0715 hours one enemy infantry at 900486 going west to Weiden; at 0720 hours two horse drawn carts going west to Weiden on Merzbruch road; at 0725 hours, 2 enemy on bikes at 925471 going east on military highway; at 0750 hours one enemy truck going east at 900486 on Merzbruck road; 0755 hours at Verlautenheide tanks and trucks were heard; at the same time 6 horse drawn carts loaded with enemy troops went

into Haaren northeast; at 0827 hours 3 trucks heavily loaded with enemy troops going very fast traveling east at 931498; at 0843 hours, 4 horse drawn carts leaving Linden southeast at 905498; at the same time 2 horse drawn carts on Merzbruck road going east at 919485. G Co picked up two Greeks who say they are forced labor, have cards signed by Major Post. They report the enemy sending children through our lines for information.

- O857- Lt Carroll to S=3: Decoy patrol brought back a man, wife, and child who left Aachen. He said all men under 50 were being picked up and put in uniform for the purpose of defending the town. He confirmed that General Schwerin is in command of Aachen area. This general said they should hold out until Oct 25th when a new secret weapon would be ready. He was taken to a battalion CP at 838408 and said that there is a tank dug in there wellcamouflaged. He reports a company CP at 837407; a machine gun nest at 837406; said the last outpost was at 837404. He was certain of a minefield at 833404, 837404. He believes there is a minefield area at 837404 to 840403.
- 0900- S-3 to Green: Make an overlay of those 3 minefields and send it in.
- 0905- S-2 to Red3: What is new? (Red 3) The enemy is still out front. One group moved 50 yards and bumped into enemy, another moved 150 yards and bumped into enemy. (S-2) Indications of last night's show is alot of vehicular movement. (Red 3) People on our right were warned an hour ago by their G-2 to be on guard for an attack. A Co patrol last night sent out 50 yards to the front and waw an enemy outpost, but by-passed it and went to fence house, and found enemy in it.
- 0919- S-2 to Blue 2: What is new? (Blue 2) Nothing much; at 0515 hours K Co reported hearing tanks going northeast at 20 degrees and about 800 yards away. That is all the dope we have.
- 0920- Delight 2 to S-3: We just fired a concentration at Haaren with two battalions of lights, two battalions of mediums, and one battalion of 8 inch. Each battalion fired 4 volleys each. That is where all that vehicular movement is. We had night concentrations on that road all night, 31 concentrations counting the TDs.
- 0925- White 2 to S-2: OP reports at 0811 hours three enemy entered building at 914486 and left in a hurry going north; at 0825 hours enemy motorcycle and command car going east at 931498; at 0907 hours one platoon enemy infantry and three vehicles at 914483.
- 0935- Dextrose White to S-3: We are getting direct tank fire at 864425. Are you firing? (S-3) Decoy may be firing, we are not.
- 0945- Lt Carroll to S-3: At 0312 hours Divarty reported enemy vehicular traffic heard at 8541. Dextrose said they heard some vehicular movement in front of their I Co 865416, they also received harassing fire during the night. Decoy reports vehicular movement about 0510 hours in front of their White Bn. Harassing fire on Dextrose throughout the night, the fire was heaviest around 2200 to 2400 hours, not concentrated. 4th Cav contacted enemy patrols at 952130, 004048, 000035, 979120, 007107, and 010109, all enemy driven back. Enemy still occupies cross roads at 009989. No other contacts reported. Identified FW from 3rd Co, 416th Repl Bn at 912955.

- 0945- Delight 2 to S-2: We have 48 rounds of propaganda leaflets. (S-2) Ok, I will figure out where we can use them.
- 1005- Decoy Blue 2 to S-2: OP reports motorcycles, ambudances, foot troop, and staff cars moving south at 849454. Tank movement all night going northeast; trucks coming in.
- 1010- S-2 to G-2: Gives him summary of the reports up this hour. (G-2) 39th and 47th jumped off this morning at 0830 hours.
- 1030- S-2 to White 2: What is new? (White 2) There is traffic around Verlautenheide. What about saying somewhere in Germany? (S-2) No, you can't use it.
- 1045- Red 2 to S-2: OP reports enemy at 935434 trouble shooting wire; enemy at 937440. A P-38 bombed about on a 50 degree azimuth, and a large column of black smoke can be seen coming up. (S-2) Gives them the reports from the other units.
- 1050- Lt Carroll to S-3: 6 horse drawn artillery pieces and 6 vehicles entered Haaren from northeast at about 0800 hours. They are going to put air on it, if they can get it. Notorious jumped off this morning at 0800 hours. No report from them as yet. They reported they had a quiet night last night.
- 1115- Blue 5 to S-3: We would like you to change the route or pull the Decoy Blue kitchens, because they must have had some light as we received some artillery fired in here last night. Our kitchens are around 182 in basements.
- 1116- S-2 to Delight 3: We just had some come in, single guns; 16th rounds since 1050 hours, they came from the northwest. We are taking azimuth from shells an OPs and do like we did in Caumont. (Delight 3) Our cub could not pick them up.
- 1151- Lt Carroll to S-3: G Co, 39th Inf 883283, F Co 986274, 3rd Bn, 39th Inf, K Co moving north to E Co's sector for support, no other change for notorious. 297th Engrs established a road block vicinity of 007363 and recieved artillery fire.
- 1240- S-3 to Delight 3: Why didn't you knock those guns out. they are knocking the buildings apart. How about throwing some direct fire up there. (Delight 3) If you have a place to shoot we will shoot it. (S-3) Shoot along the tops of the hill, and in back of Cruxifix Hill. (S-1) The enemy has been seen at these places during the last fewwdays: 872436, 875443, 877455, 881455, 885445, 883450, 883448, 887449, 887453, 896450, 903445, 907442, 915435, 919437, 925435, and 430437. About two rounds each, double load at 896450 and 903445. (Delight3) The wind is coming from 6000 azimuth.
- 1245- S-3 to Blue 3: How are you doing? (Blue 3) A few shells once in awhile, but they don't bother us much. K and L Cos are Ok, haven't heard from I Co lately. There is plenty of enemy out there, and we shoot mortars at them and they shoot at us. (S-2) We are laying some phamphlets out to the pill boxes in front of you today.
- 1250- S-3 to Decoy Blue: How are things going, any shelling? (Decoy Blue) Shelling coming and going. (S-2) We are laying some phamplets up north along the hill near Point 30.

- 1300- S-3 to White 3: What does your OP report? (White 3) 30 enemy personnel milling around a haystack at 912495 adjusting artillery. (S-2) Notified them of laying phamplets on enemy. Also gave him the latest G-2 report.
- 1315- Message from G-4: Expenditure of 105 Howitzer M-3 of 1/3rd unit of fire per day authorized 27 Sept 1944 is revoked. During period 280600A Sept to 050600A Oct ammunition expenditure is restricted as follows: 105 Howitzer M-3 500 rounds, 81mm mortar light 2, 166 rounds, 81mm mortar WP 250 rounds.
- 1320- Maj Post to S-3: We are in the process of moving the civilians. (S-3) Will you have finished by tonight? (Maj Post) Yes, we will.
- 1325- S-3 to Red 3: What is your situation? (Red 3) Same as usual. (S-3) How do you like the new ammunition? (Red 3) No advantage to it and it has very limited use
- 1327- Message from G-6: New location PW cage 794372 opened 281200A.
- 1330- White 2 to S-2: Freeport OP reports at 1255 hours at 912495 there were 30 enemy with equipment milling around.
- 1335- White OP to S-2: A Flying Fort was just shot down. 3 of the crew bailed out and Jerry went after them at 913416. Plane hit in Wieden. There is another fort flying away in apparent trouble.
- 1337- S-2 to G-2: Gives him the above report on Flying Forts. Our OP can see a gun flash at 808414. (G-2) I don't know if that is ours or enemy.
- 1350- Decoy Blue to S-2: A plane was shot down 1000 yards north of K Co.
- 1353- Decoy Blue to S-3: We are sending out 3 patrols tonight. The 1st one is going to 8743, 2nd to 883449, the 3rd to 867436 and 873436. They will start after midnight.
- 1354- Blue 3 to S-3: Just a few minutes ago a bomber was shot down. At 0920 hours L Co heard motor movement 1000 yards to the front. 3 new foxholes north of house at 914433, we fired 81s and hit the dugout. Enemy is in brick house at 92054310, saw cigaretts in area. At 1010 hours enemy was seen building a fire in woods at 915431; at 1030 hours six enemy were walking around at 911437; at we fired 81s at them. M Co fired indirect machine gun fire from mortar position
- 1355- Lt Carroll to S-3: Armored made contact by patrol with 113th Cav and 8th Belgian Brigade. CCA is in vicinity of K-5862; CCB vicinity of K-6068; CCR vicinity 6168. Latitude continued to close in assembly area. Powerhouse and Custom continued active patroling to their front.
- 1400- Capt Ralph to S-3: We are with everyone. No activity up here to speak of. Do you think we should lay double lines to the battalions? (S-3) Yes, but by different routes.
- 1410- Delight 2 to S=3: Are you getting any fire now? (S-3) Not for the last hour and a half. (Delight 2) We poured some on that hill, if they shall again let us know and we will pour more to them on it. We are giving the enemy the same as you are getting. We have a battalion zeroied on a house 913484, believe it is a CP and are giving them hell everytime they move.

- 1410- Lt Carroll to S-3: Notorious reports enemy dumps in vicinity of Manninsburg and Verlautenhiede according to civilians. Dumps are said to be camouflaged as hay stacks. One dump is 100 meters west of main road going into Verlant. BSS reports that 9/10 of the city of Aachen has been destroyed or badly damaged by air bombardment, 1000 civilians remain in the city and about 20,000 refugees from the city are in the suburbs. Equivalent of only one battalion of SS troops are holding the city proper, they are sworn by oath to remain in the city, even if it capitulates and oppose occupying forces by any means possible. Unestimated number of SS troops and concrete fortifications in Aachen, and Haaren area. Proposition of SS personnel to Wehrmach in this area is 1 to 3. Conveys that are observed are bringing ammunitions and troops into the city and evacuate the civilians. A large enemy ammunition dump located in Hastenrath. It is reported that the enemy have been preparing a defensive line running south from Dusselford to east side of Erft Canal, to Weilerswist (367405), to Euskirohen (327297). Dextrose fired on enemy OP in Aachen at 141414, saw men on top of houses who had good observation. Divarty fired a concentration on the town of Haaren this morning. Decoy reports an enemy mortar battery in vicinity of 869459, active enemy OP at 875457, enemy battery of 105s at 874456.
- 1515- Blue 2 to S-2: Just in front of L Co outpost line they have set up a line of b booby trapped hand grenades and trip flares. Also have across road at this point, 10 AT mines 918432. We are making up an overlay and sending it in.
- 1525- Decoy Blue to S-3: Plenty of enemy traffic going in and out of Aachen northeast at 855464, can we get an air mission.
- 1526- G-2 to S-2: From Decoy as of noon today: they saw a battery of mortars at 869458, could that be yours? (S-2) Could be. (G-2) Enemy OP at 875457. Defensive position greater than a company strength at 873456 to 884456. Enemy battery of 105s at 874456.
 - 1535- S-2 to Delight 3: Gives them above imformation as reported by Decoy.

 (Delight 3) We knocked out an enemy OP that was well camouflaged, one round knocked off the camouflage, and then we poured in more to finish it off. Sporadic time fire being put on Cruxifiz Hill. 8 inch Howitzers are being fired on hill north of Aachen. The cub picked an enemy gun firing in a gully be Verlautenheide and we fired on them.
- 1545- G-2 to S-2: The General is anxious that all males comingout of Aachen be sent to Division PW Cage. We called Divarty on the traffic reported on the road out of Aachen, and the Colonel also called Corps requesting air.
- 1556- Red 5 to S-3: Our new Rear CP location is 600 yards due south of Point 36.
- 1606- White 3 to S-3: Amything going on? (S-3) Not a thing. The artillery spotted what appears to be an observation post sticking out like a sore thumb and they threw an 8 inch shell on it and blew the camouflage out! Then hit it with a battalion concentration. They are also throwing air bursts towards Cruxifix Hill. (Red 5) Anything new coming up. (S-3) No everything is quiet.
- 1618- White 2 to S-3: Our OP reports a large convoy of personnel carriers filled with troops moving east oto west at town of St. Joris at 925496. Can you get air on it? (S-3) Will try.

- 1619- S-3 to G-3: Relays above message and asks for air mission. (G-3) We will try to get it, in the meantime get artillery on it.
- 1620- Delight 2 to Delight 3: Relays message regarding traffic. (Delight 3) Lt Stabler called it in and we relayed it to Divarty. They are getting cub up. We are getting data now.
- 1625- White 2 to S-3: What about the air? (S-3) Division is trying to get air. How many vehicles? (White 3) 30 at first, 12 more by now. (S-3) Divarty is going to have a shoot on it. They are sending up the cub to spot the target.
- 1638- Lt Carroll to S-3: Custom ran into enemy pill boxes which were manned. 117th Inf blew up enemy pill boxes, other pill boxes fired at them whenever they stick their heads out. Latitude closed into its assembly area, also 7th Armored Div. They plan to push at 0600 hours. They are to protect the Limey right flank. The Limeys have withdrawn 3000 to the little Rhine to the south 5,000 lst Airborne (British) missing. One battalion of enemy attacked across the river E-6075, but is being held up by 8th Armored and one battalion British 43rd Div. Down in the south of us, the 5th Inf Div is encountering heavy opposition, enemy infantry and tanks including the 11th Panzer Div.
 - concentrating in front of the 182nd Corps of the 3rd Army, Many small counterattacks on all front. Forward troops of the 83rd Div are at U-8590, 0524,P-0014 Tactical report as of 1305 hours from at K-9443 marshalling area bombed; at K-9446 box cars on siding; at K-9847 5 box cars on siding; at K9847 5 box cars on siding; at F1046 200 cars in marshalling yard; at F-1752 train of 20 box cars going west; at F-1842, 40 box cars with engines on siding; considerable activity noticed in all this area. Picked up train coming west with 30 cars at F-3429 all the way through that area to Cologne.
- 1647-Blue 2 to Capt Whitney: K Co report 12 rounds of enemy 60mm mortar shells lander at point 59. Estimate enemy mortar position at 910440. Six man enemy patrol was intercep ted by outpost at 911433, the outpost fired on the patrol, who then withdraw to the northeast. At 1552 hours L Co fired 60mm mortars at 92054310 believed to be an enemy position. At 1642 hours K Co enemy mortar which were firing believe to be in the vicinity of 914438. Also heard some small arms fire coming from Co E. Believe Co E is firing on enemy chow line.
- 1653- G-3 to S-3: We are to have air on it. Corps is handling it. They are out of our control. See if you can see them work on the road and let us know.
- 1705- White 2 to S-3: Vehicles in vicinity of St. Joris went west from there over to Linden, then went out of sight.
- 1715- S-3 to G-3: Gives them above report.
- 1718- S-2 to G-2: Gives them the report on traffic at St. Joris. (G-2) Our big guns are firing on St. Joris and they say that the town was knocked down.
- 1730- Message from G-6: Effective 290800A 1106 Engineer Group with two combat battalions is attached to 18th Inf and will reinforce position now held by 18th.
- 1732- Blue 2 to S-2: Any dope? (S-2) About an hour ago at 925498, 42 vehicles loaded with troops going to Linden. Lots of traffic in and out of Aacheen, we tried to get air but they couldn't see anything.

- 1750- White 2 to S-2: What is doing? (S-2) Nothing. What is the story on shooting a chow line? (White 2) We didn't shoot but did see enemy standing up about 500 yards west of 61. We saw the usual traffic along the Norweiden road. In addition to the 42 vehicles there were 78 foot soldiers, some men were carrying long poles, two men to a pole.
- 1800- S-2 to G-2: Gives the above report from White.
- 1810- S-3 to Decoy Blue: Can you give me the coordinates of your night fires. (Decoy Blue) 852457, 856453, 866456. (S-3) Have your kitchens moved. (Decoy Blue) No.
- 1815- S-3 to White 3: Can you give me the coordinates of your night fires? (White 3) The same as always, no change. (S-3) What about patrols? (White 3) Normal security patrols. Our artillery observer saw and fired on 2 enemy vehicles, 2 carts and 11 men at 916468.
- 1820- S-3 to Red 3: What are you doing about night fires? (Red 3) No change and no patrols.
- 1822- S-3 to Blue 3: What are your night fires? (Blue 3) I will have the artillery officer call you back on that. No change in the patrols.
- 1825- Message from G-4: Effective immediately and until further notice you are authorized to expend 1500 rounds 3 inch gun HE ammunition for indirect fire during each period 0600 Sunday to 0600 Sunday. Previous restriction rescinded.
- 1850- S-3 to Delight 3: We want harassing fire on 928471, 879467, 91054645, 92264500, 92784426, 93034446, 912439, 86884535, 87454605. What night fires are you shooting for the battalions? (Delight 3) For Blue--Points 70, 75, 914439, 913441, 92134345; Decoy Blue 852457, 856543, 866456. I will call you when I get White and Red.
- 1852- White 2 to S=3: Our OP reported at 919469, 80 to 90 enemy seen going southeast on foot into woods at 1832 hours. The artillery fired on them, but we would like plenty more artillery put on them.
- 1900- G-3 to S-3: Did anything come of the air? (S-3) Air went over but did not get on target. Convoy went to town of Linden. (G-3) Did tank company make relief? (S-3) Other company is Ok. Company was to go off the alert at noon and the new company is on alert now.
- 1905- S-2 to G-2: Notifies them of the 80 to 90 foot troops at 919469.
- 1908- S-3 to G-3: Our new CP location is at 903393. We have wires in but aren't moving until later in the evening. We will notify you wehen we move.
- 1910- S-4 to S-3: The new water point will be at 886343, and will be open at daylight.
- 1928- Blue 3 to S-3: Patrols for tonight are-contact every hour left to right. K Co patrol to pill box, will get as close as possible and booby trap it. At 920431 is factory believed to have enemy in it, and L Co patrol is going out to look. At 913432 enemy approaching K Co, but we are firing mortars at them. We don't know their number, but no vehicles.

28 September 1944 1930- Decoy Blue to S-3: Fired machine guns today to see if enemy withdrew and recieved machine gun fire back from them. At 873438 there are a couple of houses with machine guns in them, we knocked the houses down with mortars. At 864447 we drew fire (machine gun), also got plenty of 150. (S-3) At 925498 a convoy of 40 vehicles going east into town south of Linden, we tried to get planes on it but they flew over and didn't see them. We have M-10 firing indirect fire on the cross roads.

- 1945- White 3 to S-3: Co E reports at 2330 hours last night an enemy tank was 600 to 800 yards in front of their right flank firing towards G Co. At 0210 hours a sniper firing from a pill box 100 yards in front of 2nd plateon. At 0325 hours enemy vehicles 2000 yeard northeast of them. At 1745 hours spotted enemy mortar position 300 to 400 yards on 360 degree azimuth from center of company. At 1700 hours 15 to 25 enemy with mess kits 500 yards in the woods. At 1800 hours at 2000 yards 70 degree azimuth a house with chimney smoke, someone occupying the house. At 1815 hours one enemy 200 yards in the woods, BAR took care of it. Reports from 4.2s and 7th Field -- On east-west road at 914485 horse drawn carts and movement at 0900 hours. At 0930 hours one enemy platoon same place going west. At 1700 hours a few enemy personnel went into house at 914485, also went into house 100 yards east of the first house. Same sniper 300 to 500 yards in front of OP.
- 1950- G-6 to S-6: Have you moved yet? (S-6) Not yet, but will just as soon as it is dark enough. K Co reported enemy approaching them, but fired mortars and they think they withdrew. adfelement
- 2040- Blue 3 to S-3: L Co contacted C Co., all quiet. Heard enemy digging in at 914435, and horse drawn vehicle at 918435 also enemy mortar there.
- 2044- Decoy Blue 6 to S-3: I was just talking to Col Horner about our plan to use his tanks in case I am threatened and he doesn't know about it. Could you let me know about it? (S-3) I will take care of it.
- 2048- S-3 to Blue 6: Discussed the use of his tanks if Decoy Blue is threatened, and Blue 6 suggests getting them from Decoy.
- 2100- G-2 to S-3: Civilian picked up today by Omaha said all civilians had been told to evacuate Aachen because heavy artillery is being moved in there in preparation for a counterattack Saturday merning, also sa w fresh troops moving into Aachen wearing Russian campaign ribbons. Also saw a few enemy tanks at 929444.
- 2120- S-2 to G-2: Enemy six man patrol worked to 912432, and we chased them off. Another tried at 913432 and was mortared by us. Enemy heard digging in vicinity 914433 at 2030 hours. Horse drawn vehicle in vicinity of 919435. Enemy has been active today at 920431. Decey Blue put on an indirect firing demonstration this afternoon and drew fire at 873438. Two or more guns at 873445. Enemy mortars fired from 895455. 15 enemy with mess kits in vicinty 901443. A couple of snipers in that vicinity. There have been some single green flares at 9044 tenight. I believe from indications more troops in vicinity. (G-2) Things indicate a counterattack tomorrow or the next day. I look for something tomorrow morning. Let me know if you get any more ideas.
- 2135- S-2 to Red 2: Gives him the above information. (Red 2) Horse drown vehicles or artillery heard, enemy still active. We received mortar and artillery fire . but on lesser scale. A concentration on C Co left flank.

- 2150- S-2 to Blue 2: Gave him information from the message at 2120 hours. (Blue 2)
 On road at 890454 enemy registering gun there, very heavy shell. The shelling
 is about the same, 10 rounds in K Co area in the last hour, 5 rounds at a
 time, at half hour intervals. There is extra patrolling by the enemy. (S-2)
 There seems to be a strong point at 863447/ (Blue 2) I think tomorrow is the
 day for something to happen.
- 2200- S-2 to White: Gives him the summary of intelligence reports. (White 2) There was a fire fight on the left flank of E Co towards I Co about 10minutes ago.

 Karas thinks the enemy is trying to take the pill box that was the closest in. 2 enemy were picked off at 75 yards at this point. Indications are that the enemy is filling up the woods to the northeast and can jump off at any time.

 I think we can look for something, everyone is alerted. Trip wires have been installed to hold them off until mortars can get in.
- 2215- S-6 to G-3: What is the ammunition set up? (G-3) There is no worry that I know of with the exception of M-3. (S-6) If there is any shortage I want to know because there is a definite build up out front, and I want to be able to fire plenty in case of an attack. (G-3) Yes, I know.

 (Maj. Lauten takes phone and gives info on bombing raid, quating Captain O'Brien "The best I've ever seen". Also mentions PW taken who said Svagoda Regt replaced 60th PGR two days ago in the Ey lines).

- 1901 Lt. Celze G-2 to Pfc Moskowitz: PW picked up by Dextrose, belongs to SVOBDA Regt which came from Czechoslovakia two days ago. PW belongs to 1st Bn which relieved 1st Bn of 60th PGR in line two days ago. More information as soon as we get it.
- 1930 White OP reports: At 922483 house there, hedge rows around house have either prepared positions or booby traps. This observed by Ey activity around the house, at 930470 and 925471. They are dug in positions, camouflaged. From traffic on military highway, Ey CP appears to be at 919483. On bombing mission we had, most of the bombs went into the factories. A formy couple of fires in back of Weiden. There are mortars firing on Freeport. The above is all Freeport reports.
- 1915 Maj. White to Capt. Hall: Anything new in Ey Arty hitting you out there? Ans: No. The arty, heavy, seems to be ours and from here seems to be going north of AACHEN. It is a long way out from us. E Co got about 50 rounds of Ey arty prior to the bombing; one casualty from E Co and one from G o. Maj. Lauten takes phone and gets the following info from Capt. Hall: Patterson at OP said he first observed the Bn of Ey people at 919514, traveling road to southwest, part mounted on bikes and part on foot; going a good clip. Believed traveling on both sides of the read, took at least & hour to pass a single point. They Ey disappeared in gully at foot of hill. No arty fired on them but air worked over the area. There was considerable straffing, several fires were started VORWEIDEN. One good fire at Atsch: much black smoke from this area. Ey activity report: 922483 prepared positions, fields of fire cut out of hedges, etc.: 903448 Ey activity in this area all day, few troops in area.; 914485 A big house at railroad and road crossing, man on roof of house, our arty fired here.; 925470 - Ey digging in (emplacements) we fired 155's, good hits observed at 5:30 today working on emplacements. (Maj. Lauten discusses Ey situation with Capt. Hall. S-2 regards situation as still indicating a possible attack by the Ey). S-2 gives new PW identification of Svaboda, relieveing 60th PGR.

- 2000 Capt. Whitney to Dagwood White Arty OP "Xray-Obee":
 Sgt. Beckman: This afternoon bembs landed over ridge
 from here but bembing looked good. Fighters straffed
 Verlautenheide. Have heard no Ey arty firing since
 dark. Some heavy friendly arty has been landing in
 Wurselen area.
- 2010 Col. Peckham to Maj. White: Do you know anything for me? Ans: No nothing in particular. Had bombing mission this afternoon, as you know, bombs hit near out E Co. It killed a couple of Jerries. Will notify you if anything comes up.
- 2010 Pvt Wineberg Blue Bn to Cpl Belonga: "K" Co outpost fired on a 6 man Ey patrol at 910433, think that they wounded two or maybe killed them. 30 rounds of mortar just fell behind OP in the last & hour.
- 2025 Maj. Lauten to Lt. Oldsey: (Tells what the units saw and the observation for day. PW picked up by Dextrose check from Africa Korps, he belonged to the Svadoga Regt, who is the commander of the outfit. 2nd Bn of outfit formed 4 weeks ago in Czecheslavakia, arrived two days ago. Went into the line immediately, another German unit that sector. He does not know anything about an attack. One company of 150 Russian mortars 12 in a company.
- 2040 Lt. Carroll to Sgt. Minno: Dextrose captured a PW today. He was from the 1st Co., 1st Bn, Svadaga Regt. His regt arrived night of the 27th of Sept. from Czechoslavakia. Came by train to the town of Julich. They relieved another unit, probably the 60th PGR. This unit was garrison troops in Czech. Decoy sent patrol out from K Co., Dextrose at 1730 yesterday; got back 1230 hoday. Route N from Vic., of A Co., Decoy; to point 836412, saw Ey coming at them from 3 directions; previous to this they picked up a PW: they ducked in a house with PW. Civilians in the house told them to hide in the cellar. The Jerries searched the house but not the cellar. While there, they heard a field gun firing 842414. They took off at 0730 and got in at noon. 110th Regt, made limited advances towards Ey fortifications. knocked out bug pill box which held them up for 3 days, How was bombing? Ans: It was a success. (473254)

- 2120 Capt. Hall to Maj. White: Did you have word from Decoy Blue during the last half hour? Ans: No. Capt. Hall: They got hit. CP is onfire, and no one was hurt. Col. Peckin was over here. They threw arty in and it was heavy concentration, probably med. stuff. White: Col. said to get patrols out early in the morning. Slip patrols out to feel out Ey, so we can eliminate the Ey element of surprise if he attacks. Blue is sending out patrols up N this evening. Did you hear new identification? Ans: No. S-3: 2nd Bn of Svaboda Regt. On your toes tonight. How's arty up there? Ans: Very quiet.
- 2130 Maj. Lauten to Sgt of Decoy Blue: Are you in the same place? Ans: Yes, just a little gas fire but all out now and everything OK. All quiet except shell that came in on us. (Maj Lauten gives PW Inf.).

- 2150 Maj. Lauten to Lt. Olsey G-2: Tells about paper taken off the dead German.

- 2320 Red reports neg, except mortar fire falling in C area.

- 2355 Lt. Rameriz to Col. Grant: G-3: Negative report.
- 2400 Capt. Dinsmore to Lt. Rame riz: Some arty landing in front of Cm its doing a let of good. (Don't know whose arty it is).

- 0602 G-3 to Capt. Clark: Some flares are reported in front of Decey E Co. A few rounds of artillery in Dextrose area about an hour ago, but there doesn't seem to be any signs of a counterattack.
- 0605 Blue: K Co patrol contacted L Co. L Co patrol contacted C Co. Two K Co patrols to the front and returned, but did not hear or see a thing.
- 0615 White: One flare in front of E Co just before 0600 hours, otherwise everything is quiet.
- 0630 Capt. Clark to G-3: Negative report.
- 0705 Decoy Blue: Negative report. L Co OP reports about 25 civilians coming from the north and going towards the west carrying personal belongings with them.
- O715 Blue: K Co had 10 enemy try to infiltrate through their line, and they killed or wounded 4 and are going to investigate. The two L Co patrols are back. One patrol on the left flank went to the factory at 920431, and established a listeneing post and didn't hear anything. The other patrol went 500 yards south of point 70, established a listening post and didn't hear a thing. There was no activity around the pill box. They heard a vehicle going from west to east around point 75.

- O720 Capt. Clark to G-3: 10 enemy tried to break through K Co area and they killed or wounded 4 of them and they are goint out to investigate it. heir patrols established listening posts and didn't hear anything. Decoy Blue reported about 25 civilians coming from north going towards the west carrying personal belongings.
- 0730 Blue: Tell Maj. Lauten we are sending down 5 PWs. They wounded and I am sending them through the Regimental Aid Station so Capt. Gercke can interrogate them.
- 0735 Capt. Whitney to Delight: It was quiet in the Dagwood front last night. K Co had 10 Jerries try to break through them and they wounded 5 of them, they are sending them in for interegation.
- 0820 S-2 to White 3: What is going on? (White 3) Nothing Very little artillery. A flare was reported out front (S-2) K Co had 10 men try to break through and they wounded 5 of them. The rest got away. (White 3) Here is a couple of Freeport reports At 0730 hours a civilian car was seen on military highway at 925471; at 0750 hours saw what they believed to be 3 buses going west into Linden at 908497.
- 0823 S-2 to Blue 1: Have the prisoners been brought in yet?

 (Blue 1) No, one was wounded in the arm, the other

 4 are hit in the stomach, only one is very bad.
- O825 S-2 to Decoy Blue: What is doing out there? (Decoy Blue)

 At 2240 hours a little firing out 800 yards to the

 front. K Co patrol had nothing to report. K Co picked

 up one PW and that he is on the way down to you. Lots

 of civilians in front of us trying to get into our

 sector, but we are not allowing them in.
- O825 Lt. Carroll to S-2: Here is the continuation of the report on Svabeda Regt. PW says one company from his regiment have 150mm Russian mortars, but are with another regiment now. here are two companies on the line 851411. they were organized in Czechoslavakia. he average age is 28. hey left Czech., by train Sept. 24. Regimental Commander(s name is Lt. Col. Svaboda. Morale is not to good. his PW had fought in Chech., Russia, Finalnd, France, and with Rommel in Africk.

- O838 Blue 2 to S-2: We have one of the prisoners here, the others are litter cases. He is from 11th Co, 27th Regt. They were on patrol. He said he is a soldier so doesn't want to talk. He said bombing didn't do much.only wounded two. They moved out of Atsch into fields around town. I will send him down. We had one man wounded from L Co from one of the pill boxes. He saw enemy standing in doorway of pill box, but was shot in the arm before he could do anything. We are laying mortars in on it now.
- 0840 S-2 to Red 2: Anything doing? (Red 2) Negative report all night. Some mortar and artillery fire coming in. At Point 75 we put plenty of fire and aren't receiving fire from there now.
- O845 S-2 to G-2: During the night scattered mortar and artillery fire out to the front. This morning enemy patrol of 10 men tried to break through K Co. We wounded 5 and took them prisoners, the other 5 got away. One said he was from 11th Co, 27th Regt. He said bombing didn't do much damage, two of their men were wounded in it.
- 0849 Decoy Blue to S-3: We found two new minefields; one at 878438, 20 mines the other at 882441, 30 mines.

 In addition the AT gun which we had previously located moved from 877423 to 882435.
- 0912 Lt. Carroll to S-3: Divarty picked up (6) enemy gun locations at 933506, 921503. Decoy picked up family of Germans who were to move out of their home to make room for German troops. Their home is located at 827405. They report the following: Bridge is out at 828406. The bay of the bridge is mined with Teller mines. Enemy mortar fire comes from 859425. Big restaurant booby trapped at 832413. Houses on Maria Theresa Street from 827405 to 828406 are booby trapped. Booby traps appear on mail boxes, beds, chairs, closed doors, and are pull type ignited. Decoy Red B Co sent combat patrol to 818400, machine gun fired on them. It jammed and they knoced it out with hand grenades. Patrol then fired on by two enemymachine guns at 816403. A Co patrol went to 818418. Located pill box and tunnel occupied by enemy. A large fire was reported 8000 yards north of Dextrose Blue CP.

- 0940 Omaha 2 to S-2: I wanted to get some information on the patrols that went to 930434 and 920431. (S-2) The one that reached 920431 established a listening post. The other patrol approached 930434 but did not get within 100 yards of it, and were fired on by snipers beyond that. There was no evidence of an enemy build up in the vicinity. South of Atsch they heard vehicular and cart movement. Enemy patrol reached 910433 headed towards our lines, but was intercepted.
- 9958 G-2 to S-3: Can you tell me if the church steeple is still standing on the church in Atsch? (S-3) I will have to check on it. (G-2) The reason I wanted to know is we had a report that the foot of the church is a strong point and enemy OP in steeple of the church.

 (S-3) I will let you know.
- 1005 S-6 to Red 6: How is everything? (Red 6) OK. (S-6) Did you have any casualties in yesterday's bombing? (Red 6) No, they dropped two bombs on top of the slag pile, A Co was there but pulled back in time. (S-6) How was it after bombing3 (Red 6) Received mainly mortar fire after bombing and artillery fire on cross roads. Still have the same outfits in front of us. (?S-6) What about probing that C Co did? (Red 6) C and A Cos both did some probing and both ran into stuff in front. The situation on the right is much better, armored seems to be stronger now, more Doggies. (S-6) Do you need any clothes? (Red 6) Smith is trying to dry out the enemy stuff, we need some but none available, we are doing OK though. We are well dug in and some are in buildings. (S-6) How about reserves? (Red 6) I have two platoons of B Co in position that I can move. We are getting all the support we need. We are qutting down on O'Brien. (S-6) If you have a target shoot at it. I will be down to see you.

- 1010 S-3 to Freeport OP: Is the steeple of the church at Atsch been knocked down by the bombing? (OP) The steeple is still standing, but the building has been shaken all to hell.
- 1012 S-3 to Brown? Here is your ammunition allowance for period 0600 hours 30 Sept to 0600 hours 5 Oct.: Each Infantry regiment 360 rounds of 105 howitzer, M-2, maximum charge, charge 4. Unexpended balance of previous allocation accululative. A direct line is being put in to you, we may use your OP to run air mission. How about the church steeple at Atsch, is it still standing? (Brown) I will call you back.
- 1025 Lt. Carrell to S-3: 3rd Bn 60th Inf 000319; 2nd Bn 016315; 1st Bn 991323. 115th Inf 690498, 116th Inf 665507; 175th Inf 680480; 1st Belgian Brigade K-640800, 670675.
- 1025 Brown to S-3: concerning the bombing at Atsch, there were some very close hits, but no direct hits, the steeple still stands. Felement
- 1030 S-2 to Blue 2: Have the wounded PWs left your aid station yet? (Blue 2) The Colonel said there was no need to take them back to you as three of them were practically dead, so they were sent to 1st Medics.
- 1040 G-2 to S-2: Here is some dope. BFF reports large ammunition dump at 930455 also enemy CP at 955455. Two enemy batteries one at 904495, the other at 900475. Defensive works on south side of road from Cologne to Julick, also a large supply point at 070678. In the town of Vossenack there are strong points at 040327, 062298, 010261, 043245. Three bodies of water located at 930302, 015295, 080226 were preparedby enemy to flood routes of approach to above strong points. We have the one at 930302. The lake at 015295 is an artificial lake. There are two flying bomb sites near Julick, bombs for these sites are assembled in town of Porz, close to east bank of Rhine River in vicinity of 525544. The area east of Waherheide is reported to be a large manufacturing and munitions area. Most of the works are underground and are closely guarded 543514.

- 1050 S-2 to Decoy Blue: What happened to the PW? (Decoy Blue) He was taken to the 18th, but I have made arrangements to bring him back. He should be in soon.
- 1140 S-3 to G-2: According to our White OP and Cannon Co OP the steeple is still there.
- 1150 Decoy Blue to S-2: That PW we took last night was sent back to the 18th, but is now at Danger.
- 1210 S-3 to White 3: What is doing this morning? (White 3)*
 Things are quiet, artillery and mortar fire is light.
- 1220 Message from White 2: PW report from 0100 hours 24
 Sept to 2400 hours 29 Sept. 5 EM, 2 civilians.
- 1241 Capt. Gercke to S-3: What about the PW from Decoy Blue? (S-3) He was sent to Decoy, and from there to Danger instead of here. We will get the dope from Danger.
- 1257 S-3 to Red 3: How are things out there? (Red 3) Very much the same. Not as much artillery, but more mortars. (S-3) What about the positions? L Co patrol picked up last night around 75. (Red 3) We fired that last night. (S-3) Did it let up on Briggs?, left flank? (Red 3) Yes, no small arms fire contact today. (S-3) Those PWs picked up by K Co were from the 11th Co, 27th Regt.
- 1300 S-2 to G-2: I would like to get information on a PW that Decoy Blue sent up this morning, he went through Decoy instead of through here, also on the 5 PWs which were wounded and sent to Co A, 1st Medics. (G-2)

 A paper was taken from one of the wounded men and he was from the 3rd Co, 27th Regt. (S-2) He was found in the 3rd Bn sector. It looks like it made conjunction with 3rd Bn, 27th Regt. (G-2) OK, I will get on it immediately.
- 1347 S-6 to Red 6: I just wanted to know if you were home or not. (Red 6) XXXX Why? (S-6) I am XXXXX coming up to see you.

- 1410 G-4 to S-3: Notify our Ammunition Officer that on M-2 ammunition to draw his allocation of 360 rounds from (ASP) through DAO and not his attached artillery.
- 1412 S-3 to Capt. Groves: Draw your allocation of M-2 through DAO, 360 rounds. (Capt. Groves) Yes, I know about that. Did they say anything about 60mm mortar? (S-3) No. (Capt. Groves) They are drawing 60mm for me and there is no restriction except 2/3 and I am got getting my 2/3. (S-3) OK, I will check on it.
- 1420 G-6 to S-5: Where is Fred? (S-5) He is out visiting the battalions. (G-6) Did you find out what company the PWs were from? (S-5) Yes, the 11th Co, 27th Regt. Three of them are not expected to live. (G-6) Things are shaping up, up here alright.
- 1430 Red 3 to S-2: We have a civilian here who gave up plenty of information. He reports artillery position dug in at 926471 to 928471, and at 928472 to 930473. At Glucksburg farm 929272 is an artillery CP. Underground telephone at town of Eich 876384 to Stolberg. Headquarters for the pill boxes for defense, the 7th Field are using the pill boxes now. Pill box at 932432 from there to south of Duren on road to Girellsrath two kilometeres further than where the mailroad crosses the main highway. Two huge pill boxes on both sides of the road. These pill boxes serve as a headquarters. Hitler and Goering used them for meetings. The name of the civilians is HeinrichGanzer of Munsterbusch, address Branienster #72. He is living in a house close to Busbach. He asked to have someone interrogate him. He said when we get to Eschweiler to contact Franz Brochausen at Heinrichsweg. He built most of the pill boxes, had 500 men under him, he is not a Nazi. In town of Stolberg a Wilhelm Senden helped train SS troops here. Now wears civilian clothes and has been seen behind our lines. He went from Musterbusch to Stolberg and lives on Berg St., in Stolberg. He had a radio transmitter and believe he still has it. In 1921 and 1922 he was a seperater.

- 1515 S-2 to White 2: Gives him the above information as obtained from 1st Bn. (White 2) At 1015 hours one enemy jeep going east from 925470; at 1046/hours three enemy on Merzbruck highway going east at 925482; at 1100 hours five enemy walking west on Merzbruck road at 918483; at 1135 hours two enemy on road going west at the same coordinates; at 1230 hours three enemy moving around house at 901468; at 1242 hours six enemy going westto Linden at 904497; at 1245 hours eight civilians with bags going east at 905463; at 1309 hours eight enemy going east from 925470; at 1335 hours one light tank going into Linden from the east at 904497; at 1400 hours three enemy with 3 cars going east at 906462; at 1428 hours two enemy wagons fully loaded on Merzbruck road at Vorweiden. Fairly quiet in front of us today. Some artillery between points 45 and 55. A couple of mortars landed around the CP. (S-2) How was bombing yesterday? (White 2) One bomb landed about 50 feet in front of E Co. There was no straffing in front of us, but in the woodsnear Atsch. (S-2) The big fire was in Atsch last night wasn't it? (White 2) odfelemen Yes.
- 1540 S-2 to G-2: Gives them the above report from the civilian. (G-2) PW you sent up from 1034 Replacement Bn. (S-2) Eight inch guns would probably be the proper thing to use on them. We need some photographs of that area.
- 1700 S-3 to Brown: I want you to send an observer over to the 3rd Bn in case they are counter attacked and in case of close in fire.
- 1725 G-3 to S-6: I am sending down an order tonight. No change in our mission, but we might want you to divert a little. The Old Man wants you to be pretty aggressive on patrolling.
- 17 31- Decey Blue to S-2: All our patrols tonight will be confined to visiting patrols only. (S-2) Are you sending out patrols in the morning? (Decoy Blue) NO, we are not planning to because it is too hot out there. (S-2) The Colonel wants to know if anything is cooking, you don't have to get into any trouble doing it though. (Decoy Blue) OK, we will do that.

- 1750 Lt. Carroll to S-2: Workshop B closed in assembly area vicinity of 7338. Workshop A going into 7133. Workshop B going into 7040. No change at Custom Forward element of Antelope reached 665775, 653787. One Belgian Brigade was to attack this afternoon to reduce enemy bridgehead at K-681885. Dextrose K patrol went west to road next to little Lake then north to main east-west road, turned left and went west, ran into enemy motorpool at 844399 where they saw an American jeep with enemy camouflage. A machine gun in the cellar of hourse at 838401, they by-passed it and went up road to right and were hit by a mortar barrage. Returned intact. Dextrose I patrol left L Co sector went through group of houses at 854413 and found road block with 7 Teller mines at 852411. Saw AT guns and personnel at 853419, lots of movement A reliable source reports that in the Cactus area a black Plymouth sedan is operating with 4 Gestope agents in American uniforms. The Register No. is 533301. PW picked up in front of Decoy White is from 5th Co, 404th GR, 246th Div, said 6th Co is on his right. His company has no AT or support weapons.
- 1810 S-3 to White 1: Here are the 5 L and K Cos, outposts 907435, 911433, 916432, 948432, 919431. The Colonel
 wants you to have F Co establishe an outpost line
 along that same line. In the morning a half hour
 before daylight send a patrol out to look the situation
 over.
- 1835 Decoy Blue to S-2: We are sending out listening posts about 200 yards, 5 men in each.
- 1835 S-3 to Blue 3: What is new? (Blue 3) Nothing much (S-3) Are you getting anything down there? (Blue 3) Yes, the usual thing, artillery, mortars, and machine guns. (S-3) Are you gaving any patrols sent out tonight? (Blue 3) The Colonel is coming down, see him when he gets there.
- 1840 S-& to Red 2: What about patrols for tonight? Red 2)
 The same as last night.

- 1901 White 3 to S-3: We are going to attempt to establish our outposts at the following places - 904438, 906436, at 0430 hours to proceed to 908438 to ascertain whatenemy has in area. (S-3) You should keep OP connected fairly close so enemy patrols can't get around them. (White 3) We can have every man in the battalion on outposts. The 10 Jerries who attacked K Co OP came around from the least of the outpost, and they were pretty well shot up, one dead, two seriously wounded. In regard to the first OP Kestlinger gaveme, is the one we originally had. The first he gave me according to the coordinates is on trail 200 yards near the outpost maintained there right along. (B-3) I didn't know there was an OP there. (White 3) Another OPm I think is a mistake, is the 4th one, the last letter "B", it should be something else, (S-3) Wait I will check. It is Victor. (White 3) hat is better. (S-3) How is everything over there, any artillery? (White 3) Not as much as yesterday the station out front is getting shelled with some heavy stuff, it is shelled regularly. (S-3) Did you get the new identification? (White 3) No, what is it? (S-3) The 404 Grenadiers of the 246th Inf.
- 1910 Blue 2 to S-2: I just called for my nightly briefing.
 (S-2) There is nothing much doing. One tank shot up
 Decoy Blue's OP. (Blue 2) Where was the tank? (S-2)
 They shot back at it, but they can't say where it was.
 What are you doing in the way of patrolling? (Blue 2*)
 Normal patrolling between outposts. L Co patrols at
 1200 and 0445 hours are going to 920431. At 2100 and
 0445 hours going to 920435. (S-2) Can you go to 64?
 (Blue 2) Yes, we sent a patrol there this morning doing a
 lot of booby trapping up there.
- 1938 Red 2 to S-2: Here is some dope NXX Enemy was observed in area around Point 85, also at 79; 10 enemy were seen carrying bundles of stuff, but couldn't make out what it was. Artillery that is going over our heads is coming from 45 degrees, the fire approximately 10 rounds at a time. Observation seems to think they are AA guns used as field pieces. Young was busy with civilians. Got one who gave location of two pill boxes, which Hitler and Goering visited at 155477 and 158475, on each side of the road.

The civilian also gave us information on airplane factory. His name is William Prym. He stated before our troops entered Stolberg most of the equipment and parts were sent to Bevel, in vicinity of Cologne. (S-2) How about plant and machinery. (Red 2) Practically intact. Also reported at town of Duren a place there was making V-1. The factory at Stolberg made 3 engine parts per day, and 90 million rounds of ammunition a month. The ammunition and some of the machines was sent to Vienna. The motors made used 30% less gasoline than ordinary motors. Here is what I think in regard to the civilian. We can get quite a bit of information from them, lots of them worked around the pill boxes and around this area. We should get plenty of information. (S-2) A lot of them we can't relie on as they are still Nazis, and there are plenty of civilians in town who are. I will send the Belgian Officer we have up here to talk with him and others. If they don't talk we will put Corps on them. I will see about the Civil Affairs people, they should be able to do something in this respect. (Red 2) What is the boundary between the 3rd Armored and us? (S-2) The boundary runs about the same, 150 yards beyond railroad tracks. (Red 2) How about around Busbach? (S-2) Busbach is in their area. Our lines go down to cross roads.

1945 - White 2 to S-2: Our OP reports at 0758 one civilian car at 925471; at 0750 hours three big buses going west into Linden at 908497; at 0825 K Co wounded 5 men and sent them back through medical channels; 0930 hours at 901469 believe to be enemy mortar position, and artillery fired with good results; 1015 hours one enemy jeep and 2 enemy at 925470; at 1045 hours 3 Snemy at 925485 heading east on road; 1100 hours two enemy at 925485 going east, one enemy going north on road at 903463 and went into woods at right of road at 913465, one enemy going east at 913465; 1115 hours five enemy on road at 910483 to Wieden: 1135 hours two enemy on road going west at 918483; 1220 hours enemy personnelat 901468; 1307 two enemy carts going east at 910483, one enemy on foot, 17 on bikes from Kinden going east at 904497; 1309 eight enemy going east at 925470; 1335 one light truck going west to Linden, two enemy carts and 6 enemy going west at 904497; 1400 at 906463 three enemy carts on road going east;

1500 two enemy going to Wieden; 1550-five enemy personnel at 925470; 1700 eight enemy personnel at 925470; 1230 two enemy at 913484 going west to road at 919483; 1235 one enemy bike at 901475; 1237 one enemy cart and personnel at 905494 going from linden to Wieden; 1245 two enemy at 914464 oh foot going west; 1247 six enemy going west into Linden at 904497, eight civilians going east at 905463: 1249 one enemy cart going east at 920482; 1300 one enemy gun firing 2000 yards back of Wesihen to right rear of G Co; 1730 two enemy personnel going east at 912485; 1733 one man leading one man follewing horse going northeast at 925471; 1740 five enemy personnel going southwest on military highway at 925470, turned east and went up trail in woods; 1745 two enemy personnel seen coming out of woods at 912465 went northeast on military highway; 1748 six enemy personnel coming out of woods at 930470 going west on trail to military highway and then northeast; 1800 two horses and carts going at 925470 going east, two horses and carts at 914464 going northeast. H Co no enemy activity observed, the same with F Co. G Co at point 62 noted rise of another trail at 9148 grid as a supply route, used mules and carts to haul ammunition.

- 1955 S-3 to Delight 2: Here is a good target 909468, good spot to do some harassing. No. 8 of last night was not necessary.
- 2032 Lt. Carroll to S-2: PW was from Svabodta, 5th Co,
 404th GR, PGR is GR. 404th GR is from the 97th Div.
 They left Czechoslovakia on the 24th, arrived in AAchen
 on the 26th and were in the lines on the 27th, there
 are only two companies left. Both companies in the line.
 404th at 823426 to 827427. Most of the men are from 16
 to 17 years old. 1st Co commanded by 2nd Lt. Mueller.
 15,000 civilians left in town of Aachen. 800 soldiers
 trying to get them out, two civilians were hung yesterday to teach the others to get out.
- 2050 Decay Blue to S-2: I am sending you a PW who came into our lines and is plenty hot. He wants to talk. The 2 46th Div came into Aachen on Tuesday 4 companies per battalion 130 men per company. He is from the 2nd Bn enlisted staff of the 352nd Regt. They have never been in combat. Have all new weapons. Organized near Prague. Bn CP of 2nd Bn 848438, Co CP of 6th Co at 856431.

8th Co CP at 857432, 5th Co (Weapons company) in support. 6th Co runs from 867436 to 879444. 7th Co on the left of the 6th Co from 864425 to 866437. He is French. The unit is 89% German, 9% Russian, and 3% French. They are moving the battalion CP to Haaren tomorrow. 404th is on the right, 1st Bn on the left. Their mission was just to hold. He is on his way down.

- 2100 Lt. Roehrig to S-2: Booby trap in front of K Co between 907435 and 911433 consisting of 13 booby trapped grenades and 4 trip flares. Between 912431 and 912430 two booby trapped grenades and one trip flare. The regular form has been made out and sent to the engineers.
- 2100 S-2 to G-2: What regiments do you find are in the 246th Div? (G-2) 404th GR, 352nd and 698th. (S-2) One man from the 2nd Bn, 352nd Regt was picked up by Decoy Blue and is on his way down here. They are in front of Dextrose White and Blue, also the 18th. Battalion CP is moving to Haaren tomorrow. The PW will give us the rest of the information as soon as we interrogate him.
- 2125 Delight 3 to S-3: We have a report of an enemy CP at 929471, a civilian reported it. His house is in Stolberg and it is being shelled and he is mad. He said he helped build installations and knows where they are.
- 2130 G-6 to S-6: The General wanted information on the unit now in front of us. The Colonel told about the PW and said he would notify Division when he got the complete information.
- 2258 Blue 2 to S-2: Two rounds of heavy artillery landed behind K Co, otherwise the report is negative.
- 2325 White: E Co reports movement at Point 62. OP line reports foot movement. F and G Cos negative.

2330 - S-2 to G-2: We have a PW taken in vicinity of 873434 from Hq. 2nd Bn, 352 GR, 246 Div. He is French and gave himself up. He said 404th and some 600 regt was in the Division. Two battalions to each regiment, 500-600 men per battalion, 130 men per company. Division was organized six weeks ago in Milvtoze Luschtietz. It was formerly the Volks GR 1153 and the Solbuch will show as such. 50% of the men are Navy men, the rest returned from the hospital or just out of basic. The Division CO is Oberst Weicsenberger; 352nd Regt CO is Maj. Eckersclarfer; CO 2hd Bn, Capt, Hosln; CO 7th Co 2nd Lt Gelfert. He does not know where the 8th Co is. There are two officers per company. The squads have normal organization one machine gun, squad leader has machine pistol. 8th Co has normal organization, machine guns and 81mm mortars. AT Co is 14th Co. they have 120 men and no AT guns. Each man has a panzer faust. The How. Co, has 15cm mortars. The regiment left Czechoslovakia on the 24th Sept, brought horses and carts with them. (50 in his battalion). Detrained 12 km west of Koln on the 26th Sept. Took truck to 5 kms from AAchen CThe 2nd Bn CP is in the factory northeast of street at 848437. Tomorrow the CO will hove to vicinity of Haren. He does hot know where the regimental CP is, but says it is under constant artillery fire. 7th Co is from 870435 to 880454, 6th Co from 870435 to 860425, 6th Co CP 856431, 8th Co, CP 855432. 1st Bn position is on the right of the 2nd Bn 860425 to 840424. Two observers in edge of woods, yesterday in school, this afternoon were in church 873433. Two machine guns on each side of the street at 870433, 5 men there. Two men on lower floor of building at 86754325. One machine gun with two men in small building at 86754320. Two men with a panger faust are at 866433, right at bend of road before it goes under the underpass. he division orders are to defend to the last man, but this order has not yet been given to the men. The PWs believes they have an artillery regiment, but does not know where. They expected us to surround town of Aachen, and not try to take it by a frontal assault. Police are forceably evacuating the civilians from Aachen. Many French are hiding waiting for us and PW thinks many troops will put on covilian clothes and do the same. Has not seen any SS uniforms, only army uniforms. There are 4 howitzers 400 yards from CP at 845445. They have no ammunition for mortars, because of our artillery fire the supply is very difficult.

The 8th Co had two wounded and two killed from artillery. The 6th Co has one squad on outpost, rest of the company in houses at 860433. The 404th GR is on the right and the 698th GR on the left. (This information was given to Red, White, Blue and Decoy Blue).

2330 - Decoy Blue: Negative report.
